FACILITIES

- ◆ **Bunkhouses:** Total of 58 persons in 6 separate dormitories. Mattresses are provided on all bunks. Bring your own sleeping bags or bedding and pillows. Bunkhouses have evaporative cooling systems.
- ◆ **Camping:** 200+ tent sites.
- ◆ **Caravans:** 24 powered sites. No on-site vans.
- ◆ **Kitchen & Dining Rooms:** Two available for use.

ACTIVITIES

Canoeing in the Billabong and river (canoes for hire), flying fox, **NEW! adventure playground**, skiing from boat ramp (NO JET SKIS), rafting, swimming (in river only), water slide, fishing, boating (boat ramp), hiking, bush walking, volley ball, table tennis in kitchen 2 and pioneering poles available with ropes. Raft building and pioneering activity sheets available.

FEES

(GST exempt) charged at a day rate ie. arrival before 2pm is 1 day charge

Bunkhouses

\$8.00 per person each **day**. Eg. Normal weekend (2 days) **\$16.00pp**, Long weekend (3 days) **\$24.00pp**, Easter (4 days) **\$32.00pp**.

Note: A minimum charge of 50% of the total cost of each Bunkhouse applies.

Kitchen and Dining Room Number 1

\$60.00 per day. CONTENTS: Tables and chairs, kitchen utensils, cutlery and crockery for 60 people. Freezer, **900L commercial refrigerator**, 2 commercial gas stoves, gas barbecue and auto boil urn. Gas room heater and evaporative cooling.

Kitchen and Dining Room Number 2

\$35.00 per day. CONTENTS: 2 Gas stoves, gas barbecue, urn, 2 refrigerators, tables and chairs, cutlery and crockery plus cooking utensils for 30 people. Gas room heater and evaporative cooling.

Camping

\$6.00 per person each **day**. Eg. Normal weekend (2 days) **\$12.00pp**, Long weekend (3 days) **\$18.00pp**,

Electricity

\$8.00 per **day** if power is used in conjunction with camping.

Caravans

\$6.00 per person each **day**, plus **\$8.00** per **day** for power.

Canoe Hire

\$16.00 per canoe per **day**, (canoes include paddles and buoyancy vests).

Raft Hire and Pioneering Poles

\$6.00 per raft or set of poles per **day**, including paddles and buoyancy vests. *Only materials supplied, design and construct your own raft or other structure.*

Bike Hire

\$16.00 per bike per day. Maximum 10 bikes available

Boat Launch Fee

\$6.00 per boat per day, unless camping at "Roonka"

Casual Visitors

\$3.00 per person each **day**. **\$6.00** per boat per **day** for Boat Launch fee.

Sole Occupancy

\$800.00 per **day** for up to 100 campers. Extra campers are charged at the appropriate camping/Bunkhouse fee. Includes use of rafts. Canoes are an additional **\$75.00** per day. Bikes are an additional **\$50.00** per day.

Toilet Blocks

Male, Female and Disabled. Hot showers, hand basins, toilets and laundry trough.

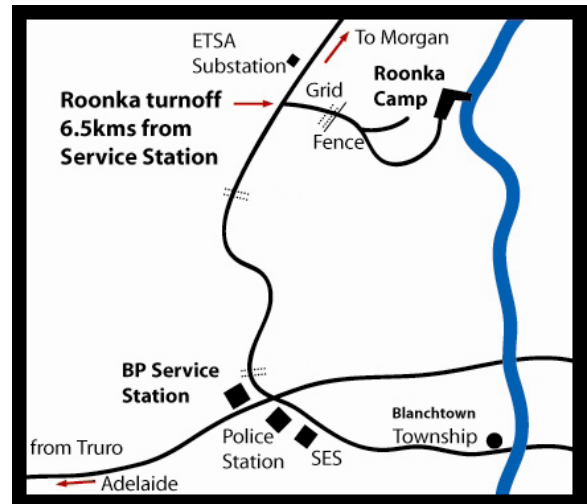
Information

Directions to Roonka

Roonka is located North of Blanchetown on the banks of the River Murray. Follow the signs from the BP Service Station at Blanchetown towards Morgan.

Blanchetown is 134kms from Adelaide along the Sturt Highway.

Travel time of approximately 90-100 minutes from Adelaide.



To assist in maintaining the camp and for the comfort of all occupants, the following rules apply:

Billabong

This is for canoeing and rafting only and should not be used for swimming.

Boundaries

Roonka is surrounded by various private properties and visitors are requested to keep within our fenced boundaries.

Camp Fires

TOTAL FIRE BAN FROM 1ST NOVEMBER TO 31ST MARCH. Two camp fire locations are available for use depending on the time of year and weather conditions. Please discuss these with the Duty Warden. Bring your own wood if possible. Fees apply for wood purchased on-site but supplies are limited.

Canoe Hire

Treat canoes with care as they damage easily. Rinse them inside and out using the hoses on the lawn before storage. Buoyancy vests provided must be worn at all times when canoeing.

Cleaning Up

Campers: Please clean your campsite before leaving and Toilet Blocks.

Kitchen/Dining Room, Bunkhouses and Toilet Blocks: Follow clean up procedure as listed at the site. Roonka is a site developed and improved for your use over many years by dedicated volunteers. We request that you do your part to assist us in maintaining the property for everyone to enjoy.

Dogs

These are permitted under strict control. Any dog found in nearby stock paddocks can expect to receive an adverse reaction from the farmer.

Information

Fees

Pay the warden prior to departure. A receipt will be issued. **No credit card/EFTPOS facilities.**

Flying Fox

Ask the Duty Warden for key to open. This activity must be supervised by an adult.

Fruit Fly Exclusion Zone

Roonka is located within the Riverland Fruit Fly Exclusion Zone. Only fruit and vegetables **purchased** within South Australia, **accompanied by a detailed purchase docket**, may be brought into the area. Random roadside checks may occur, so please ensure you bring proof-of-purchase to avoid loss of your fresh foodstuffs or a heavy fine. Further information may be sought from the Fruit Fly Hotline on 1300 666 010.

Motor Vehicles

Car Park provided. Drive slowly.

Rubbish

Bins are provided around the site for small rubbish. For bulk disposal, place rubbish bags in the rubbish bin trailer at the rear of the Wardens Cottage. Please assist us to recycle by separating bottles, cans, paper and cardboard from rubbish and deposit them in the containers by the Kitchen/Dining Rooms or at the rear of the Wardens Cottage.

Swimming

The river with its wharf area, water slide and boat ramp is the only area for this activity. For your safety, all swimmers are encouraged to wear buoyancy vests and **we strongly recommend all youth be supervised at all times in or near the water.**

Water

Limited rainwater is available for drinking from various tanks. All other taps supply river water which is only suitable for washing. Camp users may wish to bring own drinking water due to the limited and varying quality of the on-site rainwater.

What to bring with you:

Bedding / sleeping bag (plastic sheet for bed wetters), pillow, dish washing liquid, sponge / cloths, tea towels, food and drinks, matches, First Aid Kit, drinking water (see water note above). Toilet rolls are provided.
